We're carrying out early activities in preparation for major work

As part of the Hobart City Deal, the Australian and Tasmanian Governments have committed \$786 million for a new Bridgewater Bridge.

Early activities

McConnell Dowell is delivering the early activities for the New Bridgewater Bridge.

This work will add to our previous work, enabling us to complete the final design of the new bridge, and the connecting roads and pathways.

What will this work look like?

Across the Bridgewater and Granton area you will see minor drilling work on land, and from barges in the Derwent River.

You will also see our workers potholing on some local streets and pathways, which will help us confirm where existing services and utilities are located prior to starting construction works later this year.

You may also notice some divers in the river who are locating existing services.

An air quality monitoring station will also be installed in the Bridgewater area to monitor air quality before, during and after construction (please refer to the image on the back page).

How will this work affect you?

There will be some temporary changes to road, pedestrian, and cyclist access while we carry out this work. We will have traffic management in place to ensure your safety, and we encourage you to follow the directions of our traffic controllers at all times.

Navigational aids will be in place in the river for the safety of river users.

No work will take place on private property, and private property access will be maintained at all times.

When will we be working?

Work as part of these activities is scheduled to take place within standard construction working hours of **7.00am and 6.00pm on weekdays** and between **8.00am and 6.00pm on Saturdays**. No work will be done on Sundays or public holidays.




Image: An example of an air quality monitoring station. A similar unit will be installed in the Bridgewater area to monitor air quality before, during and after construction.
